

TAKE & MAKE: TEENS

FLUFFBALL KEYCHAIN

Supplies: Round fur fabric, two felt ears, small pompom, stuffing, needle, thread (60 inches provided), key ring

- 1.)** To begin, place thread through the needle. Starting from the back of the fur fabric, push needle through to the front and leave about five inches of thread left (you will need this to close the top.)
- 2.)** Moving from the front to the back and folding the edges of the fabric down as you work, make stitches along the top and around the circle (the bigger the stitches the easier it will be to close the top.) Leave an opening of about an inch at the top, as this is where the ears will be sewn in.



- 3.)** Once you have stitched around the fabric leave another five inches off the remaining thread and cut. Place the stuffing in the middle of the fabric. Taking the beginning leftover thread and where you just cut, pull the two (like a drawstring bag) to create the body of the keychain. The top will not fully close, but that is alright.
- 4.)** Place the two felt ears in the area where there are no stitches at the opening. Taking the leftover thread and needle, stitch the opening closed while securing the ears to the fabric.
- 5.)** Once the ears are secure you can put the nose on. Starting from the back of the body and leaving some thread, stick the needle through the stuffing and into the front. Once the needle is out, put it through the small pompom and onto the thread. Working from the front, take the needle and put it back through the body until the pompom is where you would like it. Tie off in the back.
- 6.)** To add the key ring, place it behind the ears and stitch though the fabric a few times to secure it.
